

STEPS TO GET OIL OUT OF CARPET

STEP 1



CAREFULLY SCRAPE OFF THE EXCESS OIL

Using a butter knife or putty knife, carefully scrape the excess oil from the top of the carpet.

STEP 2



BLOT THE AREA GENTLY

Use paper towels or a clean cloth to gently blot the stained area.

STEP 3



USE BAKING SODA TO ABSORB EXCESS OIL

Sprinkle it generously over the stain and let it absorb the oil for at least 15-30 minutes.

STEP 4



VACUUM

Once the absorbent powder has had time to work, vacuum the area thoroughly.

STEP 5



CLEAN WITH DISH SOAP

Mix a few drops with warm water and apply to the stained area.

STEP 6



RINSE AND BLOT

Rinse the area with clean water and blot dry. Ensure all soap is washed thoroughly.

IF THE STEPS ABOVE DON'T WORK

A. TRY A DRY CLEANING SOLVENT OR RUBBING ALCOHOL FOR TOUGHER SPOTS*
